ABSTRACT

Board materials, palm cards, press clippings and other materials of the Boston Gay Men's Chorus spanning 191-2008 donated to the History Project by Michael Leclerc, board member of the BGMC.

BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

The Boston Gay Men's Chorus (BGMC) was founded in 1982 as a 501© not for profit organization. The membership in 2002-2003 was 200 members, 175 signers and 25 non-signers. The budget for 2002-2003 totaled \$475,000 with corporate sponsors such as The Boston Globe, Copley Place, Delta Airlines, Fleet Boston Financial, Galliano, The Gillette Company, Harvard Medical School, IPSwitch, KY Liquid and NStar.

According to the 2003-2004 Board Member Handbook, "By performing benefits and donating tickets, The BGMC has generated more than \$100,000 for organizations such as AIDS Action Committee, Human Rights Campaign, Boston Area Gay/Lesbian Youth, Rosie's Place, Fenway Community Health Center, Boston Living Center, Positive Directions, AIDS Project Worcester, AIDS Services Monadnock Region and many others." In the Board Handbook a list of recordings is given, however, no recordings are included with the collection.

The organization is governed by a Board of Directors with a separate Executive Director and Music Director. Concert attendance in 2003-2004 was projected at 10,000 annually. According to the Board Handbook, "the BMGC unique mission requires that it define community broadly and across boundaries. Women comprise approximately one half of the audience and 55% of the donor base.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists of 2, flat, small archive boxes of 11 folders of materials dating from 1991, 1992, 2994-1995, 2002-2003, 2003-2004, 2005, 2007 (the 25th anniversary) and 2008. Most predominate and inclusive is the 2003-2004 Board Member Handbook which includes a history, a description of performances, budget, list of major donors, and a list of recordings. Materials in the collection include, the member handbook, palm cards, clippings, show bills "Tour Notes – Intermission," and other miscellaneous items. No recordings on tape, CD or DVD are included.

DESCRIPTION OF SERIES (BOXES)

Series (and Box) 1 contains 6 folders. Folders contain Board Materials, Miscellaneous Programs, Palm Cards, Quarter Notes – Intermission Material and other administrative materials.

Series (and Box) 2 contains 5 folders, consisting of 2005 programs, miscellaneous palm cards, Anniversary materials, and "Tour Notes – show bills."
